In 2001, TJ Dawe received the “**Just For Laughs**” Comedy Award in Montreal for THE SLIPKNOT and was remounted at the Just For Laughs On the Edge series, which also featured Scott Thompson of the Kids in the Hall. TJ was the winner of the “**Best Male Performer**” award at the 2002 Orlando International Fringe Festival. His solo shows are influenced by Spalding Gray, Daniel MacIvor and George Carlin. He has frequently been likened to Lord Buckley, Jerry Seinfeld and Eric Bogosian. Although he uses elements of stand-up comedy, his shows are very theatrical, exploring serious subjects and using music and physical theatre.
